

Werf Walls – remnant low walls – Early 1800s

Only about 8m of original boundary walling remain of a structure which would have enclosed much of the western side of the werf. Werf walls typically delineate the human sphere from animals, agriculture and wilderness. There is a small garden store lower down (it is fairly overgrown and currently houses an electrical installation), within the walled werf, which is not as old, and dates to c.1900; it is however also constructed of raw/ low-fired bricks in clay mortars.
